August is supposed to be the dog days of summer, but not at the lake! With these nice rains and the high lake level, fishing has been great! Nice catfish have been biting well in the evening through the early morning hours. If you can only fish in the middle of the day try casting to cover near the bank. Large cats are being caught right off the banks under cover. The catfish are hitting on shrimp and stink baits easily bought at our bait shop. Good size bass are being caught all day on a 14 inch purple worm working it slow along the bottom. Crappie and bluegill both are hitting jigs baited with crappie bites which are available also at the bait shop. Our bait shop has many sales going on right now, please stop in and see what's available! Also remember the 27-28 August is our all night Lunker tournament. We will be stocking the big cats Friday the 26th and the lake will be closed to fishing till the tournament. Please remember **absolutely no pets** are allowed at the lake.

Please help us keep the lake clean and use the trash cans beside every dock. And just a reminder, if you want to clean your catch at the lake, you are welcome to use our fish cleaning station on the boat rental dock. Please do not clean them on the fishing docks, it attracts too many raccoons and skunks. Thank you for your help!
