Hello everyone here is a ranger report to catch you up on fishing reports, with the latest rains the lake water level is high which is great for oxygen in the water! As for the fish, the bass and bluegill are still on their beds guarding their eggs. The crappies are for the most part finished breeding but can still be caught using minnows. The catfish are up and down, when the water warms up the bite is hot! When the rains cooled down the water the catfish went to deeper water. Stink baits are still the best bet.

We have the boats out ready for renting and now have shade awnings with picnic tables moved to the west side. The basketball court has been refurbished and is ready for use. The soccer nets are up and are ready for use also. Rebecca and Pat in the bait shop have been getting ready for the summer fishing season, they have new catfish baits and numerous Penn catfish rod and reel combos for sale. There is also a soft bait sale going on now with prices 30% off! I have used some of these new soft baits and caught all species of fish. Don't forget to try the Berkley crappie bites, they work well!
