October 12 – November 18, 2014

To end the summer and start the fall creel reports we are slowly but surely changing over from the ever popular channel catfish to the even more popular rainbow trout.

Oct. 12 through Oct. 30 had an ending creel of:

120 Channel Cat – 5 Blue Gill – 4 Crappie – 2 Black Bass – 48 Rainbow Trout

Moving on through Nov. 1 to Nov. 18 we have a creel of:

8 Channel Cat – 4 Crappie – 50 Rainbow Trout.

The trout bite has been slow but constant. Predominantly early morning under an overcast sky.

The lure of choice seems to be the Kastmaster and favorite bait is the Berkley Power Bait. Also a great bait is salmon eggs and live red minnows.

Please stop by our Lake Bait Shop for all your fishing supplies.

Please remember, unlike other species of fish, once you've reached your Rainbow Trout creel of 4 then you may no longer fish for trout that day. Feel free to fish for other species.
