Hello all! We hope you all are enjoying the fine fall weather and take advantage of it, and come fish with us at the lake! The larger catfish are on the move and are hitting during the day and evening. Baits of choice are shrimp, crawlers and blood stink baits. Crappie are hitting minnows jigged just off the docks and black jigs too. Bass are hitting purple worms and chatter baits. Our boats have been removed for the season but will be back in May. Our rangers and maintenance crew have been working hard clearing pampas grass and trimming trees all around the lake. This has made many areas to be able to shore fish, feel free to use those spots. The bait shop has restocked their catfish rods reels and baits and are starting to get the trout tackle in too. Trout stocking is not far away, we just need some cooler nights to bring the lake water temps down to at least 60 degrees before we can start to stock with trout.

Lake water temps lately have been around 69° – 71°
