Spring fishing is here! The crappies are moving and hitting on minnows and black and hot pink jigs! The bass are also moving into the shallow water and spinner baits are working for them too. Nice cat fish have begun to feed and quite a few have been caught on trout baits.

The trout fishing has slowed down due to the warmer waters, but you can still catch them. Spinner bait or the peach colored egg baits are working the best for catching the trout. The first 3 hours of the morning light have still proved to be the best time to catch the trout..
