June 15 - June 21, 2015

Hello! This is Ranger Eric with your SBEA fishing report! We have been stocking cats regularly since late March and the weather has finally warmed up to be more summer like! We have had lots of real nice cats caught with many of them in the 4-5lb range but mostly 2 lb eating fish. The bite is now summer typical with a good bite in the morning from roughly 6 to 9 am and of course the evening bite from 7 pm with steady feeding all through the night. Bass have moved off the beds and now are on the drop offs or in the shade of overhanging trees. Crappies have moved to being in their feeding schools so you will have to move to find them. We ask that everyone strive to use the trash cans and keep our lake one of the cleanest in the county. Also please follow all creel limits so we can keep our fishery going. As for tents, there is only camping allowed in the designated camping areas. No tents/sleeping bags/mattresses or cots are allowed on the docks.
