We ask all our members to remember that the speed limit around the lake is 10 miles per hour as well as on the lake and that you please use only stringers for your fishing or wire baskets. Also, please if you are fishing in a crowded area, please be courteous of others and try to avoid casting over other lines or relocate to a less crowded area for quiet and pleasant fishing.

Be sure to check back every few days for an up to date creel report. Until then, cast strait and set that hook!
