

## SBEA RETURN CHECK POLICY

Due to the amount of returned checks we have received recently, we thought we would give a little reminder of our check policy.

1. All returned checks will be charged a \$35.00 service fee. (Subject to change)
2. Stopped payments are the same as any returned check, with a \$35.00 service charge.
3. 2 returned checks will result in a 1 year suspension of your check-writing privileges.
4. After the 4th returned check you will be placed on a no more ever list and will not be allowed to write any more checks to SBEA.
5. Upon appeal, check-writing privileges may be restored at the discretion of the Board.
6. If you do not pick up your returned check within 15 days your check writing privileges will be suspended for 6 months.
7. If returned checks are not picked up within 60 days they will be sent to collections.
8. If a check is sent to collections you will lose all check privileges forever.
9. If you have an unpaid returned check you will not be allowed to do a payroll deduction. (Unless you want to pick up the returned check on a payroll deduction.)
10. SBEA will not take any check that does not have your name and address printed on it or any check that does not have a printed number on it higher than 300.
11. Members may only write one check a day for cash not to exceed \$20.00.
12. If your checks were lost/stolen, or returned in error, check with manager for details.


