Hello! This is Ranger Eric with your weekly SBEA fishing report! The trout that have been caught have been some beauties! Large and stocky and full of fight! I have noticed the trout are now getting wise to the rainbow and gold colored Berkley baits and are now hitting the lime green baits, the gold kastmaster spoons and I have had some success with a small Panther Martin spinner with a black blade with gold spots. They seem to like that in this clear water fished along the drop-offs. Pinkie minnows are still catching crappies and we have had a few nice catfish waking up from the warm weather and hitting the trout baits. As you move around the lake you will see areas where my partner and I in maintenance have cut and cleared some shore areas. Please enjoy these areas for added fishing areas as we are trying to provide more open spots to fish besides the fishing docks. Also check out the bait store! For all you bass and crappie fishermen, In the store Rebecca and Pat have Berkley bass/crappie baits reduced and on sale! We are fast approaching our last trout stocking of the season and this will be a larger stocking. With spring around the corner and weather warming up the trout will switch and hit larger baits. I would use pinkie minnows with slip bobbers. Good luck everyone and please take pics of your catch!
