1st Annual SBEA Sporting Clay Shoot



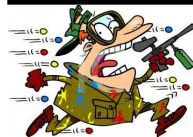
Great Prizes To Be Given Away

Join us at Shady Creek Sporting Clays Range, 1252 N. Oliver, Belle Plaine, KS. This is an outdoor shotgun range which provides a fully automated sporting clays course along a wooded creek bed. Their shooting range offers a wide range of target presentations for the entire family and all skill levels from novice to the complete shooter. Cost for members is \$20 per shooter (if registered by October 19th), \$25 per shooter thereafter and for nonmembers. Included in the ticket price; 50 targets, lunch and a ticket for some great prizes to be given away. We will award the top three shooters and have a special award for our worst shooter. Purchase a raffle ticket to win a new Remington 870 12 gauge pump shotgun. Tickets sold at SBEA, \$5 each or 5 for \$20. You can bring your own weapon & ammo or you may rent a firearm and purchase ammo at Shady Creek Sporting Clays Range. 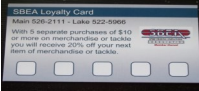

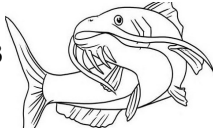
