## BLUE CATS BEING STOCKED

We will be stocking the SBEA Lake with blue catfish in February of this year. The blue cats will be a catch and release only for a period of time to allow the blue cats to help eliminate any overpopulation we have of white perch. After June 15<sup>th</sup> members may keep the blue cats as part of their catfish creel. Blue cat or channel cat will be considered the same for creel counts and length limits will be the same. It is hard to tell the difference between the two fish so the gate and rangers will be educating members as they come in the gate and as our rangers do their creel counts. There will also be photo's available in the lake store and gate that we will be showing the members to help show them the difference between the two types for fish. So please make sure you have a channel cat and not a blue cat before you put in on your stringer/basket. We are always working to keep your lake well stocked with fish for everyone.
