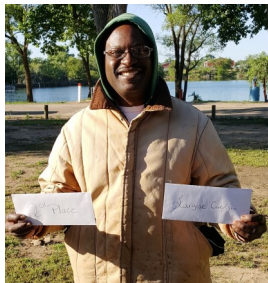

Fire pits are back and available during camping season May 26 – September 4. There are several requirements. No fire rings or fires on the ground allowed. No fires will be allowed until you check with the ranger for full details. SBEA has fire pits available for rent in the lake store as well as firewood. **You cannot set up a fire pit unless approved and okayed by the rangers.**



Cost per day will be \$20.00 deposit, \$5.00 rental with your own firewood or free rental if you purchase firewood from SBEA. Please check in with the lake store for a list of fire pit rules and application to sign. Absolutely no fire pits will be accepted on the docks or picnic areas at any time.
