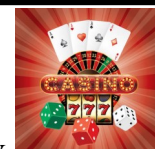

LUNKER CATFISH TOURNAMENT

May 19 & 20

Only those entered in tournament will be allowed to fish. This is a fund raiser for SBEA.



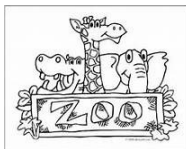
Your chance to catch the "BIG" one and take 1st place has just gotten better. Grab your fishing poles and don't worry about bait, our lake store can accommodate all your needs for this tournament. Once the fish for this tournament have been stocked in the lake there will be no fishing until the tournament starts at 8 a.m. on May 19. Only those that have paid to enter the tournament will be allowed to fish until the tournament is over. This year it is a 24 hour tournament; registration starts at 7 a.m. on May 19 and the tournament starts at 8 a.m. - 8 a.m. May 20. Weigh in time is at 8 a.m. sharp; however you may weigh in anytime during the tournament if you do not want to stay the whole time. You may pre-register at the lake store and pay your \$25 entry fee or pay any time to enter the fishing tournament. The lake will be stocked with "BIG" channel cat for this tournament. There will be 3 cash prizes for the three largest creel of 4 catfish; 1st place, (\$250), 2nd place (\$150) and 3rd place (\$100) and then \$100 if you want to enter the contest for largest catfish caught for an additional \$5.00 entry fee. All rules of the lake must be followed with no gold fish allowed for bait and 2 poles per fisherman. No buddy system will be allowed, you must catch your own fish and must be kept on your own stringer or in your own basket and kept in the water. Vehicles will be subject to inspection. Contestants will be supplied with an armband and rods used in the tournament will be tagged. Tournament ends promptly at 8 a.m. on May 20. If you do not present your fish by that time you will be disqualified, so be sure to be on time. For your convenience the bait shop will be open until midnight on May 19. This event will be open to the public however if contestant is not a member they will have to pay the \$17 day fee to enter the property. The lake will be closed for fishing to everyone who is not a contestant in the tournament. Camping will be allowed for those in the tournament on May 19.

BLUE CATS HAVE BEEN STOCKED

We have stocked the SBEA Lake with blue catfish that will be catch and release only for a period of time to allow the blue cats to help eliminate the white perch. After June 15 members may keep the blue cats as part of their catfish creel. Blue cat or channel cat will be considered the same for creel counts and length limits will be the same. It is hard to tell the difference between the two fish so the gate and rangers will be educating members as they come in the gate and as our rangers do their creel counts. There will also be photo's available in the lake store and gate that we will be showing the members to help show them the difference between the two types for fish. So please make sure you have a channel cat and not a blue cat before you put in on your stringer/basket. We are always working to keep your lake well stocked with fish for everyone.

LOYALTY CARD PLOYALTY CARD PROGRAM

We recognize the value of our existing customers and we want to reward you for your continuous business. Each time you spend \$10.00 or more on clothing, tackle, merchandise or candy the clerk will take the customer loyalty card and date and initial 1 spot. After 5 separate visits where the member spends more than \$10.00 in any SBEA store the clerk will sign and date the members SBEA Loyalty Card and have the members sign and add their BEMIS number on the back of the card. Once the Loyalty Card is full, the member will receive 20% off one (1) item of merchandise, clothing or tackle (one item only not the entire purchase). *No Loyalty card may be redeemed for any other department. 20% off offer does not apply to tickets, candy, flowers, gift cards, tools, dues, bait or red tag items.*

SBEA PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS

We are so happy to see the increase in new memberships in the past year that we thought it would be a great time to remind our members of the payroll deduction guidelines. This helps to give new members an understanding of SBEA payroll deduction guidelines and a reminder to current members.

1. Members can only do 2 payroll deductions per month and is limited to \$300.00 per deduction.
2. Member must spend \$25.00 to be able to do a payroll deduction.
3. Any amount over \$100.00 you may divide into 2 pay checks.
4. If your account balance goes over \$600.00 for any reason your account will be frozen until you have it paid down to \$300.00.
5. If for any reason your account is not paid off in 60 days you will not be allowed to do any more payroll deductions until the full amount is paid in full.
6. We will ask for email addresses so we may contact the member should we need to notify them of any payroll issues.
7. If a member does 2 payroll deductions in one week the deductions will be added together and processed as 1 deduction.
