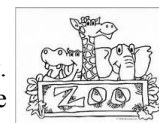

Shady Creek is an outdoor shotgun range which provides a fully automated sporting clays course along a wooded creek bed. Their shooting range offers a wide range of target presentations for the entire family and all skill levels from novice to the competitive shooter. Cost for members is \$20 per shooter if registered by September 30, \$25 per shooter thereafter and for nonmembers. (Includes 50 targets, lunch and a ticket for some great prizes to be given away). This course is zoned for shotgun shot size 7.5 or 8; any other size is prohibited.

Shooters will be given a ticket when they register for a drawing of prizes at the conclusion of the shoot. SBEA has scheduled a free Kansas Hunter Education Class for Aug. 24 & 25, 2018. This class teaches new hunters to be responsible hunters. Responsible hunters are ethical, safe and knowledgeable. By law, the course must be a minimum of 10 hours in length. Most courses are 12 hours or longer. **You must attend all nights** and pass the test the last night to get your hunter safety card. ## FISHERMEN, CAMPERS & GUESTS

### Camping Season Is Here

With camping season here, keeping the lake a safe and peaceful place is a job for everyone who visits the lake. We are asking for your help in continuing to keep SBEA Lake a safe, clean and peaceful place for all members. The docks must be kept clear of obstructions at all times to facilitate safe foot traffic, like no use of rocks, stones or bricks on the docks and help keep the lake and adjoining area clean by properly disposing of all trash and cigarette and cigar butts (not on the ground to avoid any chance of fires starting). Please respect the wildlife that shares your lake by keeping all hooks and fishing line picked up. The hooks get caught up in the bird's beaks and the fishing line end up wrapped around the birds causing great harm. We would like to remind you of some rules to help us all have a great camping and fishing season:



1. NO PETS Allowed
2. No going into the lake for any reason
3. Speed limit is 10 M.P.H.
4. Littering is prohibited
5. No public intoxication
6. No abusive behavior will be tolerated
7. No fireworks, discharging of missiles, rockets or similar projectiles

**No standing, rocking or horseplay in boats, no swimming or wading in the water will be tolerated.** This is a big safety issue for us and we have a no tolerance policy on this matter. If you get in the water at all you will be issued a citation and part or of all your membership will be suspended or terminated. Not only do you put your life at risk, you also put our staff's life at risk if they have to go in after someone. Please follow all lake rules and code of conduct to keep everyone safe and this a enjoyable facility. For yours and your children's safety, please no one under the age of 14 unattended around the water without adult supervision.
