Hi everyone! Are you all ready for catfish and camping season? From the temps it looks like we skipped past spring and summer is here! We still have a few trout hitting crawlers. Catfish are hitting stink baits, shrimp and shad baits. Blue gills are hitting spinners and small jigs. Crappies were hitting minnows but try bright colored jigs now. We have the all night cat tournament coming up next weekend! Please remember, when we stock the Lunker cats Friday, the lake will be closed to fishing. You can still shop the bait shop. Until Sunday morning the lake will be open for fishing only to those fishing the tournament. If you have a facility rented you and your guest must stay in the rented areas, the bait shop or bath house. Rule sheets if you have signed up for the tournament can be found at the guard shack and bait shop. We have the soccer nets up now so come on out and kick the ball around! Our rental boats are now available as long as the winds are not out of limits

We also want to make sure that until June 15, blue cats are catch and release only. We need them to help keep the white perch population from taking over the lake. Any white perch you catch, do not put them back in the water, you can leave them on the banks for the wild life or throw them in the trash.
