Shady Creek is an outdoor shotgun range which provides a fully automated sporting clays course along a wooded creek bed. Their shooting range offers a wide range of target presentations for the entire family and all skill levels from novice to the competitive shooter. Cost for members is \$20 per shooter if registered by October 5, \$25 per shooter thereafter and for nonmembers. (Includes 50 targets, lunch and a ticket for some great prizes to be given away). This course is zoned for shotgun shot size 7.5 or 8; any other size is prohibited.

Shooters will be given a ticket when they register for a drawing of prizes at the conclusion of the shoot. We will also be raffling off 1 shotgun & 1 rifle that day, a **Remington 700 ADL .270 Win Bolt-Action Centerfire Rifle**- Bolt action with a 4+1-round capacity, carbon steel barrel with a matte finish, black synthetic stock and X-Mark Pro trigger.
