FISHERMEN, CAMPERS & GUESTS

CAMPING SEASON IS HERE



Camping season here. Keeping the lake a safe and peaceful place is a job for everyone who visits the lake. We are asking for your help in continuing to keep SBEA Lake a safe, clean and peaceful place for all members. The docks must be kept clear of obstructions at all times to facilitate safe foot traffic. You can not use rocks, stones or bricks on the docks. Help keep the lake and adjoining area clean by properly disposing of all trash and cigarette and cigar butts (not on the ground to avoid any chance of fires starting). Please respect the wildlife that shares your lake by keeping all hooks and fishing line picked up. The hooks get caught up in the bird's beaks and the fishing line end up wrapped around the birds causing great harm. We would like to remind you of some rules to help us all have a great camping and fishing season:

1. No going into the lake for any reason
2. Speed limit is 10 M.P.H.
3. Littering is prohibited
4. No public intoxication
5. No abusive behavior will be tolerated
6. No fireworks, discharging of missiles, rockets or similar projectiles
7. No pet allowed

9. We have brought back citations to those who violate any of our code of conduct; <https://beatoday.com/code-of-conduct-ethics/>, or lake rules

No standing, rocking or horseplay in boats, no swimming or wading in the water will be tolerated. This is a big safety issue for us and we have a no tolerance policy on this matter. If you get in the water at all you will be issued a citation and part or all your membership will be suspended or terminated. Not only do you put your life at risk, you also put our staff's life at risk if they have to go in after someone. Please follow all lake rules and code of conduct to keep everyone safe and this a enjoyable facility. For you and your children's safety, please no one under the age of 14 unattended around the water without adult supervision.
