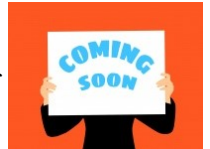

JUNE 20, 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.**



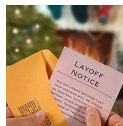

Playgrounds

We will re-open the playgrounds beginning June 6. We are asking members to please bear with us and to have patience as everything we're going through is something new for us, as it is for you. SBEA staff will do everything we can to help keep you and your family safe by sanitizing and checking the playground equipment throughout the day.



While we are as pleased as you are to see the playgrounds re-open, we know it will take the continued support of all members to keep each other safe and healthy. We are still encouraging members and staff to exercise caution and do what is necessary to continue to help prevent spread of COVID-19:

- Maintaining social distancing and gathering in groups of 50 or fewer
- Only sharing common equipment with members of the same family or cohort
- Washing and sanitizing your hands before and after using the playground equipment
- Families are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer to the playground/lake with them
- Staying home if you feel sick or have a fever

Pavilions

While we are grateful to re-open our pavilions, our priority is the health and safety of our members and their guest. We will continue to do our part in keeping each other safe and healthy by enhancing our cleaning and sanitizing routines before and after each party/gathering. We will not be starting any parties before 9:00 a.m. and will require a hour before each party for proper cleaning and sanitizing. We are requiring all members to provide hand sanitizer for their party/gathering who attend. This will be checked for during your check in with the ranger. CAMPING SEASON IS HERE

Camping season here. Keeping the lake a safe and peaceful place is a job for everyone who visits the lake. We are asking for your help in continuing to keep SBEA Lake a safe, clean and peaceful place for all members. The docks must be kept clear of obstructions at all times to facilitate safe foot traffic. You can not use rocks, stones or bricks on the docks. Help keep the lake and adjoining area clean by properly disposing of all trash and cigarette and cigar butts (not on the ground to avoid any chance of fires starting). Please respect the wildlife that shares your lake by keeping all hooks and fishing line picked up. The hooks get caught up in the bird's beaks and the fishing line end up wrapped around the birds causing great harm.



BACK FOR THE CAMPING SEASON

Camping season is here and that means fire pits are available during are available through September 7. There are several requirements. No fire rings or fires on the ground allowed. No fires will be allowed until you check with the ranger for full details. SBEA has fire pits available for rent in the lake store as well as firewood. **You cannot set up a fire pit unless approved by the rangers.** Cost per day will be \$20.00 deposit, \$5.00 rental with your own firewood or free rental if you purchase firewood from SBEA. Please check in with the lake store for a list of fire pit rules and application to sign. Absolutely no fire pits will be accepted on the docks or picnic areas at any time.
