Hello everyone!

The rains have helped the lake levels nicely! Bass are hitting rattle traps and both purple and watermelon colored rubber worms. Crappie are being caught here and there on plain minnows. Shad, shrimp and blood stink baits are hot for the catfish. Best cat bite is still in the evening and overnight on the weekends. Carp are being caught on blueberries since the mulberries did not show up this year. Pat in the bait shop has had shipments of fishing gear come in, so the Bait shop is getting stocked up. We are still taking measures against COVID - 19 and ask members to wear a mask in the bait shop. Also, effective immediately, except for overnight camping and 24-hour cat tournaments, all docks WILL be closed 15 minutes prior to the lake closing. So, make sure you have your creel and equipment cleared from the docks. This ensures you have time to load up your vehicle and be off the lake by closing time.
