Happy holidays everyone! We hope during the holidays you make time to come on out to the lake, fish and relax some! Our grills around the lake can be used for a winter cook out and the bait shop has all you need for a cook out of fresh caught fish! The trout are hitting the dough baits and crawlers. Pink minnows are working for both trout and crappie and bass too. For those who seem to be not having luck fishing while the next dock over is killing them, study the lake and species. Trout love overcast days and if there is a breeze putting a ripple on the water, even better! Fish with the winds and cast to the bank. Bring it back slow. Trout will feed on wind-blown bait pushed and cornered near the bank. On sunny days fish as close to the docks as possible or cast to shade areas on the water. Trout do not like sunshine, they look for cover. Mornings before the sun is on the lake or late afternoon when there is a lot of shade, trout will feed in those areas. Pull your baits through those areas. Let's all please remember our covid-19 spacing while fishing and in the bait shop. If someone or a family is currently fishing a dock or bank area, please do not crowd in. There are plenty of areas to fish. In the bait shop please remember to wear your mask. We are still sanitizing our pavilions and bath house and bait shop many times throughout the shifts. Good luck fishing!
