



MEMBER NEWS

To better protect and help build up our crappie population, the daily creel limit on crappie will be 10" and limit of 5 until further notice.

With summer/camping season starting, keeping the lake a safe and peaceful place is a job for everyone who visits the lake. The SBEA Lake employees work very hard to make the lake a great place for our members. Most of our members are respectful and appreciate the lake and take pride in knowing they own part of a great organization. We are asking for your help in continuing to keep SBEA Lake a safe, clean and peaceful place for all members.

We have gotten many complaints about fisherman leaving stink bait on the benches or wiped on the docks and railing. We will be addressing this problem as our rangers go around doing their creel reports. Then warning and citations will be used to control this problem. Please take care of your facility and leave it in a good condition for the next fisherman.

The docks must be kept clear of obstructions at all times to facilitate safe foot traffic. Please do not use a rock, stone or brick on the docks. Please help keep the lake and adjoining area clean by properly disposing of all trash and cigarette and cigar butts. Assistance in keeping the lake, facilities, docks, and shore clean is greatly appreciated. Please treat with respect the wildlife that shares your lake. Keeping all hooks and fishing line picked up because the hooks get caught up in the bird's feet & beaks and the fishing line end up wrapped around the birds causing great harm.

For yours and your children's safety, please no one under the age of 14 unattended around the water without an adult supervision

Camping Season is Just Around The Corner May 26 - September 4

Camping season is here and that means camping by the fire. The lake store will have fire pits available during May 26– September 4. There are several requirements. No fires will be allowed until you check with the ranger for full details. SBEA has fire pits available for rent in the lake store as well as firewood. You cannot set up a fire pit unless approved by the rangers. Cost per day will be \$20.00 deposit, \$5.00 rental with your own firewood or free rental if you purchase firewood from SBEA. Please check with the lake store for a list of fire pit rules and application to sign. Absolutely no fire pits will be accepted on the docks or picnic areas at any time.
