## Welcome October!!

One of the best months to fish our lake! The cats have been hitting large chunk baits. Try cut up perch or bluegill. Shrimp and garlic are still working some too. Morning and evening bites are still productive but we are seeing a bite from the cats at 2-4 pm. Cooler water temps are driving them to feed more. Bass are wanting spinner baits and root beer colored rubber worms fished deep and slow. Get set for trout season, it's coming soon! See the bait shop for your needs.

Any white perch caught must be killed and not returned to the lake. They are an invasive species. All bass are still only catch and release for 2024. Also let's make sure to that all fishing line and hooks get tossed in the trash cans and not on the ground to help keep the wildlife safe.

Reminder, we are now into fall hours, the lake closes at 8 pm promptly. All members need to be off the docks and exiting the lake by 7:45 pm.
