The lake has been blessed with the rains and the water level has been coming up nicely! We ask that everyone obey the 10-mph lake speed limit, please use the 50 trash cans on the lake for your trash. Reminder that all bass are still catch and release and the limit on bluegill is 5. By doing this we hope to give the bluegill, like the bass, a chance to breed. Please remember "NO PETS ALLOWED" and no glass containers. Come out and enjoy the new floating docks and use the grills around the lake for a picnic. If you rent a fire pit you get 5 free pieces of firewood, however we also have free firewood on the exit road side of the lake. All camp sites are first come first serve.
