Merry Christmas everyone! We hope you all had a great and thankful thanksgiving! We are thankful for all our members and enjoy seeing you all in the stores and on the lake! Keep looking for the Christmas sale merchandise in all the stores! Both Pat and Shauna have the bait shop decked out for the holidays and have plenty of rods, reels bait and tackle and other surprises for holiday sales ready for you! The trout are slowly coming around and biting, peach dough bait, Kast Master spoons are working the best. Cats are slowing down as are the bass but can still be caught on the warmer days. Crappie are starting to hit beetle jigs, black and pink in color or pink jig heads tipped with minnows. You will see during this winter, maintenance working on some of the older stationary docks and removing some of the Russian Olive trees from around the lake.

A few reminders, if you want to fish with 3 poles, stop in at the bait shop and get your 3-pole permit. Only \$1. Speed limit on the lake is 10 mph. All bass are catch and release still. Please if you catch a bass, get a cell phone pic and release asap. White perch are catch and kill; they cannot be put back into the lake.
