### November

Hello all!

Well, it's November and nights are cooling off fast. That's good news for you trout fishers but not the best news for you bass and cat fishers. Cats have slowed up a little, but some are still hitting stink and blood baits, cut shad and chicken liver. Bass are slowing down too but some are being caught on whacky rigs. A few crappies were caught on minnows.

As for members asking about when we are going to stock trout, this all depends when the water temps get to and stay at 60 degrees or below. We are checking the temps daily Trout are super expensive and we don't want to lose a whole stocking to high water temps. So, look to late November early December for our trout stocking. Also, a reminder for all, this Wednesday we start winter hours on the lake. We will close at 6:00 pm. All members and renters must be off the lake by 5:45.

A few reminders, if you want to fish with 3 poles, stop in at the bait shop and get your 3-pole permit. Only \$1. Speed limit on the lake is 10 mph. All bass are catch and release still. Please if you catch a bass, get a cell phone pic and release asap. White perch are catch and kill; they cannot be put back into the lake.
