I can't believe that the members are catching trout. One member who caught a trout told me that 5 nice trout followed his trout to the dock. If you want to catch trout now try fishing deeper as the trout are down in the colder water.

Crappie are staying down in around 10 ft. The bass and the blue gill are moving up into the shallows to start building their nest.

Where are the catfish? Your guess is as good as mine. Just when I get them figured out they change their pattern.

This is important. I want to remind everyone that the lake will be closed to anyone who is not in the Lunker Catfish Tournament. We will close the lake to fishing at 6:00 p.m. Friday until 7 a.m. Sunday. (We will have a picnic area set up so you can come out and visit your spouse, son, daughter, etc. if you are in the tournament).
